

Short CV of Gabriel P. Krestin, M.D., Ph.D., FACR, FRCR

Gabriel P. Krestin is full professor of Radiology and Chairman of the Department of Radiology & Nuclear Medicine at Erasmus MC, University Medical Center Rotterdam, the Netherlands.

Dr. Krestin graduated from the Faculty of Medicine at the University of Cologne in Germany in 1981 and completed a residency in radiology at the same institution in 1988 and his PhD thesis in 1989. Dr. Krestin moved to the Department of Radiology at the University Hospital in Zürich, Switzerland in 1990 where he became associate professor of radiology. Between 1995 and May 1997 he was the acting chair of the same department before he moved into his present position in the Netherlands.

Dr. Krestin is a the Past President of ESMRMB, Past President of ESR, Past President of IS3R, and served on the editorial and advisory boards of numerous international journals. He received the Albers Schönberg Medal of DRG, the Schinz Medal of the Swiss Society of Medical Radiology and the Gold Medal of the European Society of Radiology, and was awarded the honorary membership of numerous national radiological societies and a honorary fellowship of the ACR and of the RCR. In October 2017 he was elected to the National Academy of Science, Engineering and Medicine (US).

He is author of over 400 original articles, of over 70 book chapters, and editor of 7 books. His main areas of research are: imaging of abdominal organs and cardio-vascular diseases, molecular imaging and population imaging.
